



Loe Bar is a large bar of sand which separates the sea from the Loe Pool. It is a 15 minute walk from the Site. Dogs are permitted on this beach all year round. **(Please note it is NOT safe for swimming here).**

Penrose Walks, owned by the National Trust, form a circular route around Loe Pool, ideal for anyone who enjoys walking & cycling. There is a circular walk / cyclepath around Higher Penrose Farm with access from the Camp Site (see map on the back). You can cycle from the Camp Site into Helston via Penrose Walks avoiding all traffic on the main road. Just go down the farm lane, into the National Trust Car Park opposite the white thatched cottage, & follow signs to the Walks & Helston. Cycling is permitted on all the paths around Loe Pool - although more care must be taken through Degibna Woods.

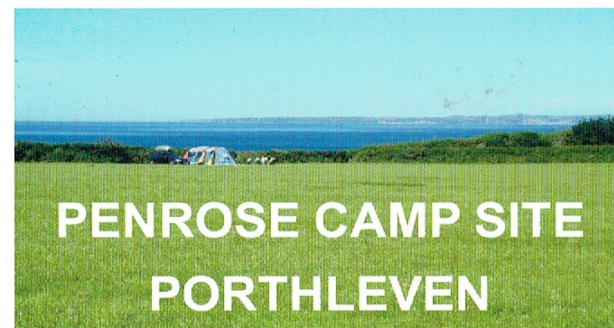


To walk or cycle to Porthleven - go to the far end of the Toilet Block field, through the gate, across the next field to the gate in the far corner.

Go straight along this hedge to the road, which will take you down either into Porthleven or to the Coastal Footpath.

**Local Facilities:** Porthleven - Sandy Beach under 1 mile (see above), Skate Park, Supermarket, Pubs, Restaurants, Takeaway Food, Beauty Salon, Barbers & Post Office.

**Local activities** - Fishing Trips, Surfing at Porthleven (for the experts) or Praa Sands, Golf Courses at Mullion or Praa Sands, Horse Riding at Cury & Mullion.



Enjoy camping in the peace & quiet of the countryside with no restricted pitch sizes! Just use the space you require & enjoy the freedom of choice.

From the site you are 5 minutes from the picturesque walks around the Farm & Penrose Estate, the Coastal Footpath & Porthleven Village.

The site is open for the months of August. On-site facilities include toilets & free hot showers. Well-behaved dogs are welcome & campfires are allowed.
